# FIVE YEARS OF IMPACT

REVITALIZING DES MOINES NEIGHBORHOODS



Five years into this work, Invest DSM's impact is clear — and growing. But neighborhood revitalization isn't easy. It takes strategy, patience, and a willingness to tackle complex challenges head-on. We have prompted nearly \$80 million of investment, improved over 1,300 properties, and awarded more than 750 grants to homeowners and dozens of small businesses.

The real impact of our work is what's happening on the ground. Vacant storefronts are becoming thriving businesses, homeowners are working on deferred maintenance projects, and new families are putting down roots.

In 2025, our work in Des Moines continues to grow as we expand into additional Special Investment Districts. At the same time, we continue to strengthen our core programs to meet community needs — supporting homeowners, business owners, and developers with the resources to invest in a stronger, more vibrant future in Des Moines.
